Brothers and Sisters in Christ, as you know, Pope Francis has called our Universal Church to celebrate a holy year by inviting us to reflect, pray and put into action, that which distinguishes us as a community of baptized and, at the same time, express the ideal to which we aspire: to be "Merciful like the Father."

The Holy Father invites Catholics around the globe to discover God's mercy and extend forgiveness to others. The Church offers the sacrament of Reconciliation as a means of intimately experiencing God's mercy and receiving grace.

The Sacrament of Forgiveness

The forgiveness of the sins committed after Baptism is conferred by a particular sacrament called "The Sacrament of Conversion, Confession, Penance, or Reconciliation." (CCC 1486)

The Year of Mercy invites to the sacrament of Reconciliation.
